Unit 1 – Introduction to Intergenerational Practice and Intergenerational

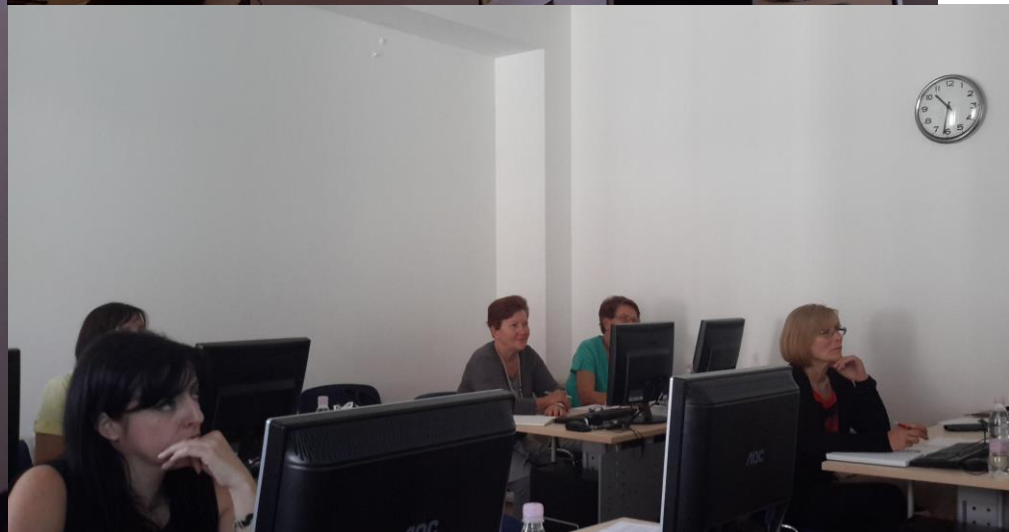
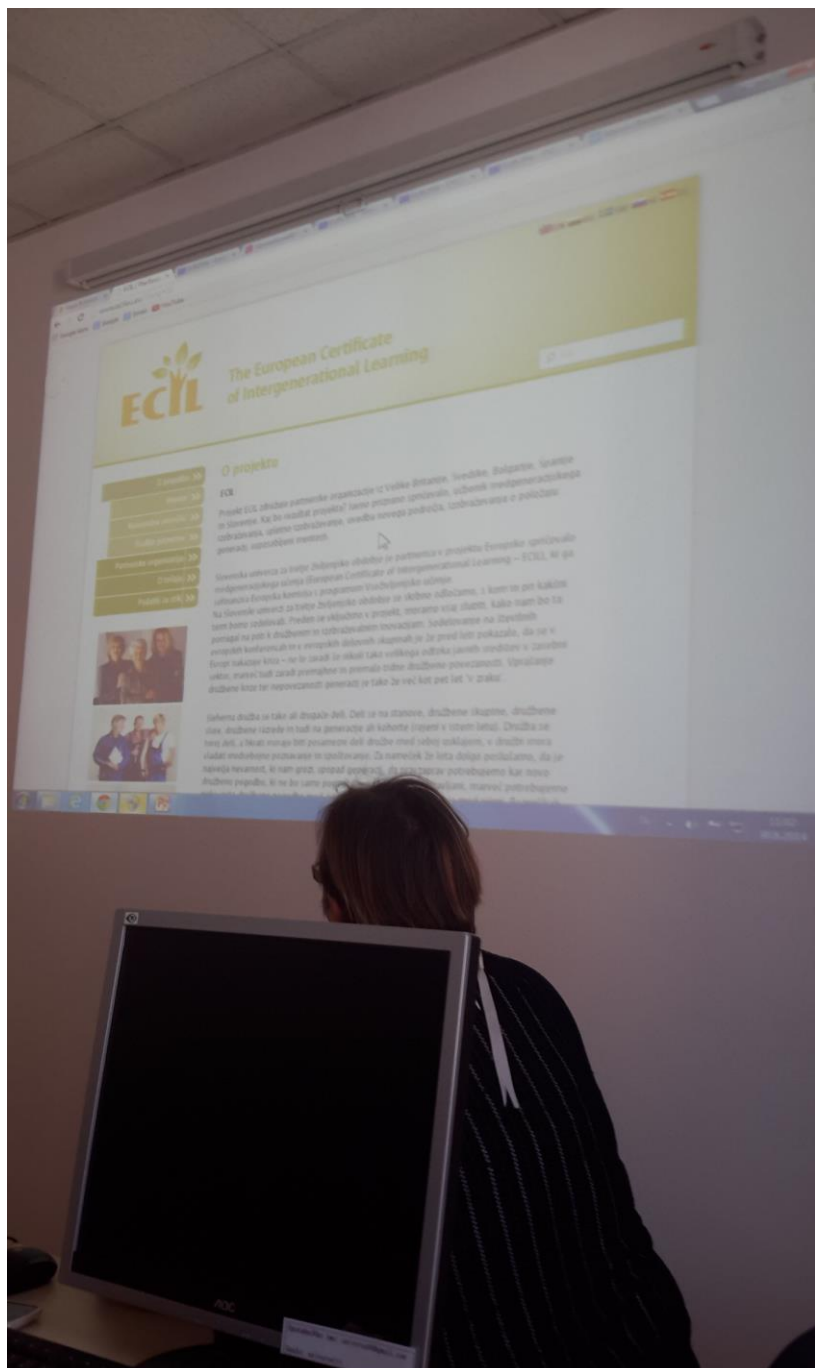
Learning: This unit introduces you to what intergenerational practice and intergenerational learning + benefits are.

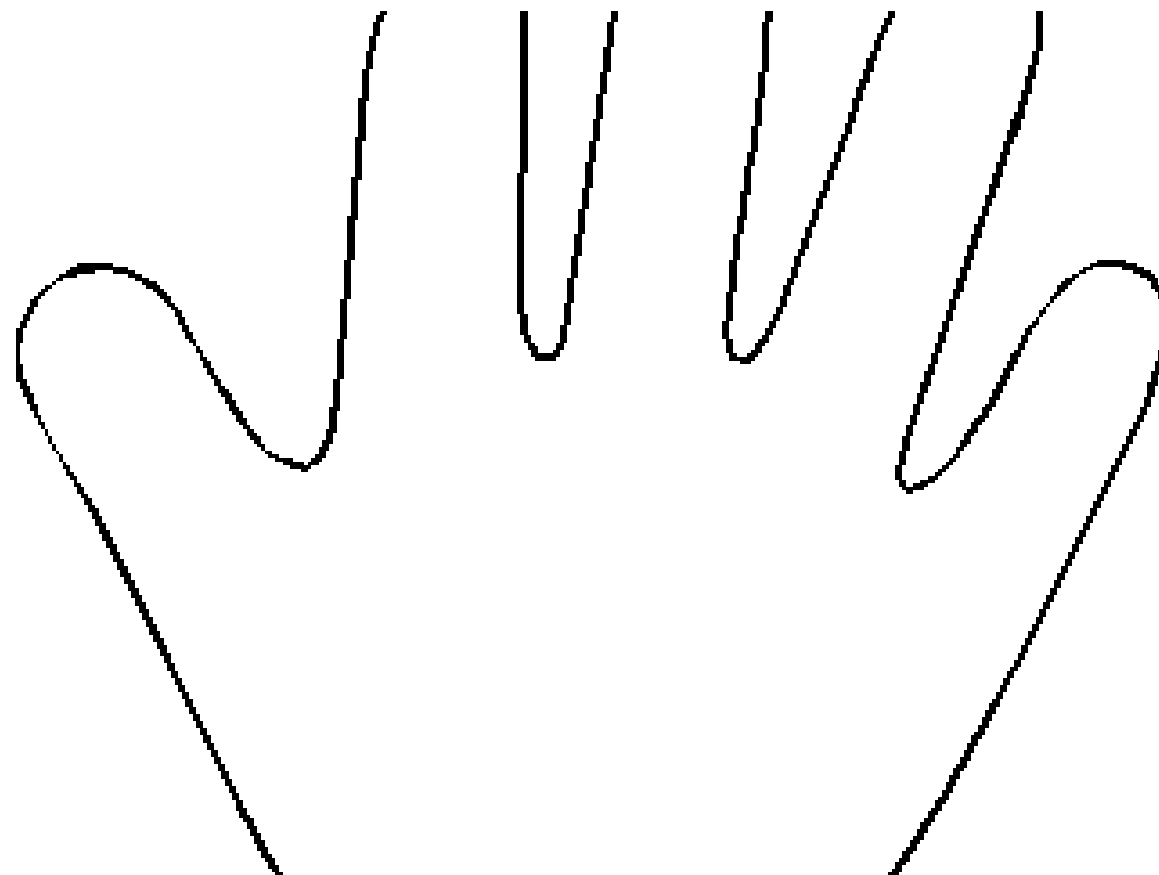
