Question: Which is the largest city in Bavaria?



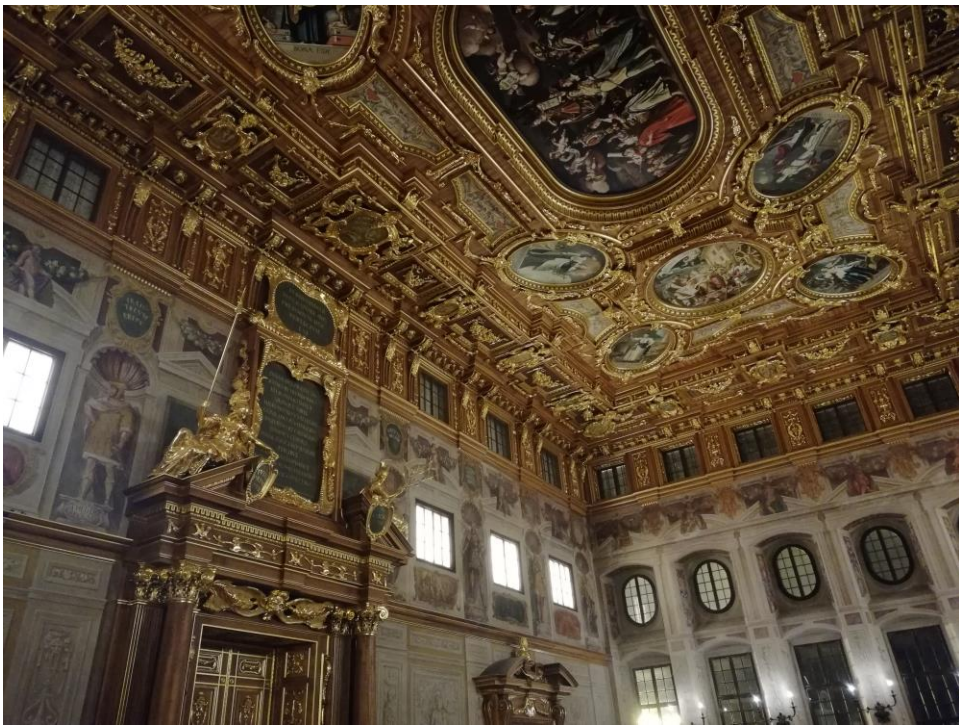
