3. Articles (over 310) in Slovene and Foreign Publications

Mrs. Ana Krajnc, PhD, professor emeritus, graduated in psychology and pedagogy at the University of Ljubljana. She was the researcher at the Institute of Sociology and obtained the PhD at the same university. Her post-doctoral studies were at the OISE (Institute for the educational studies) at the University of Toronto, oriented to adult education. As the national coordinator in international Study of Adult Education and Social Participation she published her first publication in English at OISE, Toronto. Her knowledge has been upgraded in Geneva and Oxford. As the professor of andragogy (adult education) she introduced the new undergraduate and graduate study program at the University of Ljubljana. Later she continued her research in an international group for Comparative Adult Education at UNESCO and was an expert representative of International Council for Adult Education at UN in Vienna. She was visiting professor at the University of British Columbia in Vancouver. She co-established the Slovene Third Age University, network of 51 local universities with 21000 students, and she is acting as its president. She established the first Slovene Journal on Adult Education /Andragogic Perspectives/ and was its editor for 20 years. Her 8 books and many chapters in books abroad and at home cover the learning processes and adult education. Her articles number over 300 in various journals. She developed the study programs of andragogy in several new universities in Slovenia, and teaches in post graduate programs at the University in Ljubljana and University of Maribor. In 2015 she established the Institute of Dyslexia for the people who face the learning difficulties, but can be very creative and innovative as well, if their talents are properly released. She is well known public lecturer and continuously cooperates with public media (radio, TV, newspapers). Her last book published in 2014 and reprinted in 2015 is popular and well accepted in practice. On the basis of her international projects she was the first in Slovenia to spread the care for functional literacy and now for computer literacy, e-administration, e-health and e-learning, especially for older learners and low educated people, because it is the condition for active citizenship.
